- Started Helping Hand, Dehradun dedicated to providing medical help to hill people
- Treats over 500 patients free of cost every year, suffering from **burns** or are **mauled** by animals - Patients are mostly poor, hill women from remote villages in the Himalayas
- Govt hospitals redirect complicated cases of burn & bite, to him due his expertise
- Organized 14 days camps in remote villages, consecutively for the last 13 years
- Still lives in rented house, with very limited earnings – had converted the hall into a dispensary & place to perform surgeries when he returned from the US in 1983
- Believes "designations are responsibilities more than pride"



- Arranges medicines, conducts medical camps, blood donation drives
- Set up Sujan Sundarban a free medical service centre at his own residence in Chandanpur after Bengal floods of 2000
- Before starting Sujan, worked as a visiting doctor in remote flood prone parts of Bengal, having limited government services
- Has treated more than 4,000 people
- From a poor Dalit family, had worked as tutor to raise money for his studies, rent & meals



## Moozhikkal Pankajakshi

## Pavakalli ke Pankajakshi

- Preserving the traditional art form of Nokkuvidhya Pavakalli, currently under the threat of extinction
- Since the age of 8, she has performed across Kerala, India and the World
- Nokkuvidhya Pavakalli is an indigenous puppet theatre form practiced from 5 centuries by Pankajakshi's ancestors in Kerala
- It narrates entire Ramayana & Mahabharata
- The art form requires extreme concentration and practice, balancing and animating the puppets perched atop a pole standing vertically on one's upper lip
- **Passed on** the knowledge of the art to her granddaughter K S Ranjini

- Started Sambhav, a resource center for farmers across the country - where they visit to exchange seeds & learn organic farming
- Sambhav has successfully grown many vanishing food crops such as clove bean, jack bean, black rice, sword bean amongst others
- Transformed 36 hectares of **degraded land**in Nayagarh district, into a food forest by soil
  & water conservation techniques
- The forest has over 1,000 species of plants & 500 varieties of rice, and supports a Seed
   Bank with 700 indigenous varieties of seeds
- Run 'Adopt a Seed' initiative which gives region specific seed varieties to farmers for free on the condition that they popularize it
- Radha Mohan is a retired Economics Prof, while Sabarmatee is a Conservationist








### **Kushal Konwar Sarma**




## **Shyam Sunder Sharma**

# Sundaram Verma

## Sanvahniyata ke Sikar

- Farmer who grew 50,000 trees with a watersaving technique 'dryland agroforestry' that requires only 1 litre of water per tree, in the arid Shekawati region of Rajasthan
- His technique involved leveling the land to prevent rainwater from draining away, ploughing the fields multiple times to remove the weeds & capillaries, planting the saplings in deeper and wider pits, pouring 1 litre of water in it and allowing the plant to grow
- Set-up 6 nurseries, distributing 1,50,000 saplings among farmers
- Collected & preserved local varieties of seeds, crops and plants
- Recognised for his outstanding work in the afforestation of dry lands and conservation of Bio-diversity
